Amendment to the Statutes for Admission to the Master's Program of Water Science and Engineering at Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT)

dated April 21, 2021

Pursuant to Article 10, par. 2, cl. 5 and Article 20, par. 2 of the Act on Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT Act – KITG), as amended on July 14, 2009 (Bulletin, p. 317 f.), last amended by Article 1 of the Second KIT Further Development Act (2. KIT-WG) of February 4, 2021 (Bulletin, pp. 77, 83 f.), Article 7 of the Act on Admission to Higher Education (HZG) of October 15, 2019 (Bulletin pp. 405), Article 33, par. 5 of the Higher Education Admission Ordinance (HZVO) of December 2, 2019, last amended by Article 1 of the Ordinance of the Ministry of Science on the Modification of the Higher Education Admission Ordinance of June 29, 2020 (Bulletin, pp. 499), the KIT Senate on April 19, 2021 adopted the following Statutes.

Article 1

The Statutes for Admission to the Master's Program of Water Science and Engineering at Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT) of April 26, 2019 (Official Announcement of KIT No. 24 of April 30, 2019) are amended as follows:

- 1. In Article 2, par. 2, the date "December 15" is replaced by "November 30".
- 2. After Article 9, the following new Article 10 is inserted:

Article 10 – Selection Procedure for Higher Semesters

- (1) If quota for admission to the 2nd and higher semesters have been specified according to the valid Ordinance of the Ministry for Science, Research, and the Arts on the Specification of Admission Numbers at the Universities of the State of Baden-Württemberg (ZZVO), all applicants for the same semester according to Article 7, pars. 1 and 2 HZG will be ranked based on the following criteria:
 - 1. Study and examination achievements reached so far and
 - 2. result of a selection interview as specified in Article 9.
- (2) For ranking the applicants, the study and examination achievements reached so far are evaluated with 0.5 points per credit (maximum 60 points) and the result of the selection interview is given a maximum of 100 points. The points reached are added (maximum 160 points).

(3) In case of the same ranking, lots will be drawn.

(4) As for the rest, Article 3, par. 2, Nos. 1, 2, and 4, Article 5 of these Statutes, and Articles 3 and 4 of the Statutes of Universität Karlsruhe for the Admission Procedure to Higher

Semesters Based on Study Achievements Reached, as amended, will apply."

The following Articles will be numbered consecutively.

Article 2

These Statutes will enter into force on the day after their publication in the Official Announcements of KIT. The Statutes will apply to the application for the 2021/22 winter semester for the first time.
