Amendment to the Admission and Enrollment Regulations of

Pursuant to Art. 10, par. 2, No. 5 and Art. 20, par. 2 of the Act on Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT Act – KITG) of July 14, 2009 (Bulletin, pp. 317), last amended by Art. 2 of the Act on the Amendment of the Act of Baden-Württemberg on Universities and Colleges and Other Acts (Gesetz zur Änderung des Landeshochschulgesetzes und anderer Gesetze) of October 26, 2021 (Bulletin, p. 941), Art. 58, par. 1 and Art. 59, par. 1 of the Act of Baden-Württemberg on Universities and Colleges (Landeshochschulgesetz, LHG) of January 1, 2005 (Bulletin, pp. 1), last amended by Art. 1 of the Act of the Act of Baden-Württemberg on Universities and Colleges and Other Acts of October 26, 2021 (Bulletin, p. 941), Art. 20, par. 3 and Art. 33, par. 1 of the Higher Education Admission Ordinance (Hochschulzulassungsverordnung, HZVO) of December 2, 2019 (Bulletin, pp. 489), last amended by Art. 1 of the Ordinance of June 18, 2021 (Bulletin, pp. 518), the KIT Senate on April 25, 2022 adopted the following Statutes:

Article 1

The Admission and Enrollment Regulations of Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT) of October 22, 2021 (Official Announcement of KIT No. 65 of October 22, 2021) are amended as follows:

In Article 5, par. 4, the following clause 4 is added:

"Students from a partner university of KIT, who wish to start their studies at KIT under a doubledegree program run together with this partner university, may, if they cannot provide the above proof, still be admitted, provided that they prove the required language proficiency by the end of the 2nd semester passed at KIT at the latest; in this case, they must prove at the time of their application that they possess knowledge of the German language corresponding to the level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) at least."

Article 2

The present Amendment enters into force on the day after its publication in the Official Announcements of KIT.
