Sixth Amendment to the Admission and Enrollment Regulations of

Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT)

of February 26, 2025

Pursuant to Art. 10, par. 2, No. 5 and Art. 20, par. 2 of the Act on Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT Act – KITG) of July 14, 2009 (Bulletin, pp. 317), last amended by Art. 2 of the 5th Act on the Amendment on University Regulations (5. Hochschulrechtsänderungsgesetz) of November 12, 2024 (Bulletin 2024, No. 97, pp. 47), Art. 58, par. 1, cl. 2, and Art. 63, par. 2 of the Act of Baden-Württemberg on Universities and Colleges (Landeshochschulgesetz) of January 1, 2005 (Bulletin, pp. 1), last amended by Art. 1 of the 5th Act on the Amendment of University Regulations of November 12, 2024 (Bulletin 2024, No. 97, pp. 1), the KIT Senate on February 17, 2025 adopted the following Statutes:

Article 1

The Admission and Enrollment Regulations of Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT) of October 22, 2021 (Official Announcement of KIT No. 65 of October 22, 2021), last amended by the Statutes of January 17, 2025 (Official Announcement of KIT No. 4 of January 23, 2025), are amended as follows:

In Article 21, cl. 3, the word "third" is replaced by the word "fourth".

Article 2 Permit of Announcement

KIT is allowed to publish in KIT's Official Announcements the wording of the Admission and Enrollment Regulations of Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT) in the version valid as of the entry into force of the present Statutes.

Article 3

This Amendment enters into force on the day after publication in the Official Announcements of KIT.
